Dear Parents,

Free School Meals

You will see your child's name and follow the prompts. Although there is no charge for meals, you must remember to 'check out' for your order to go through.

Reception Joiners:

Please refer to the letter sent via ParentMail on 14/7/23 detailing your child's schedule. Please only book a meal for the full day they will be completing this week. Please then book ahead each day from the start of next week onwards.

Uniform Transition

Children **Year 3 upwards** will be required to wear a shirt and tie.

Children **Year 5 – Year 6** have the option to wear a blazer.

Year 5 & 6 Walking Consents

For those previously in Year 5 with walking consent, this will roll over to Year 6. If you want to discontinue, please let the office know. For those transitioning from Year 4 to Year 5, please collect a walking consent form from the office Wednesday onwards.

Please continue to provide a **small snack** for their morning break and a water bottle. Snack boxes & bottles must be labelled. Boxes / bottles left behind at school will be disposed of each Friday after dismissal for hygiene reasons. You may provide an additional snack if your child will be attending an after school club. Water bottles are refillable at each of our water fountains.
