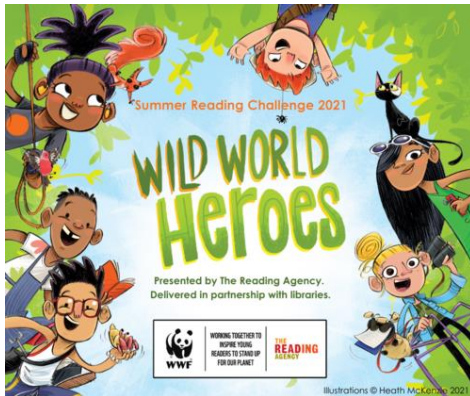
We're teaming up with WWF for a very special nature-themed Challenge that will inspire you to stand up for the planet!
