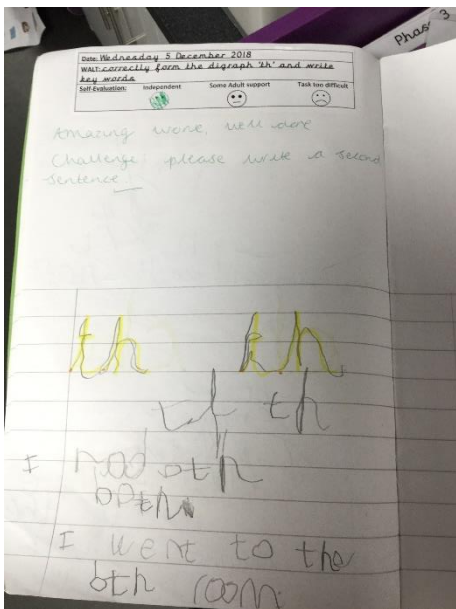
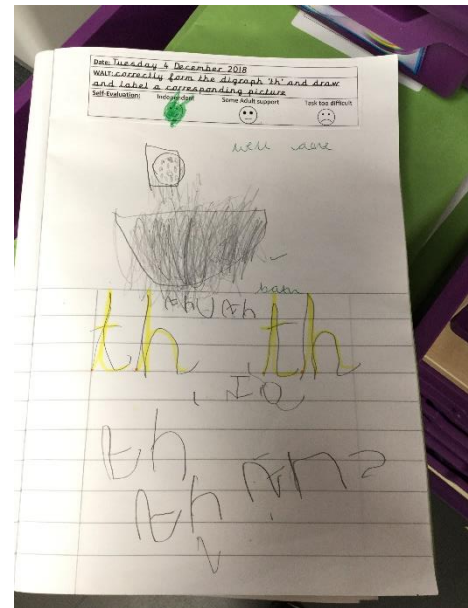
Dear Parents,

Throughout the week we have been focusing on Christmas and have been busy with play practise. The children did really well in their rehearsal and are looking forward to more rehearsals with all of Reception and year 1 next week!

During our literacy sessions the children have been making greater strides in writing and reading using their phonic knowledge. We have also been focusing on the digraph th, which is one of our trickier digraphs to pronounce.

In Maths the children have been completing activities with sand timers and stopwatches to understand and use the language associated with time. We also looked at the days of the week, seasons, months and years!

Our provision in the classroom has been themed around Christmas activities and crafting and the children have produced some wonderful creations during their play.
