## Year 2 Hawking Weekly News

### Autumn Term 2018

Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018

Dear Parents,

This week the children have completed a quiz on Salvador Dali and Henri Matisse. They loved testing out their knowledge learnt throughout this topic and were excellent at sharing facts with others.

In English we looked at instructions and the use of time connectives and imperative “bossy” verbs. The children worked in small groups to invent their own game and write instructions for it. We had a combination of Christmas related board games and memory games.



Our Maths lessons focused on numbers and place value. We worked on how to partition 2 digit numbers in different combinations of tens and ones which has been a challenge for some. We will work on this more in spring term. We also looked at rounding numbers to the nearest multiple of ten and the use of ordinal numbers. The children enjoyed working out the secret messages using ordinal number codes.



This afternoon we went to the church for a Christmas play rehearsal with the other Year 2 class and the Year 3 children. The children were excellent at singing their songs and poems aloud for all to hear!
