Dear Parents,

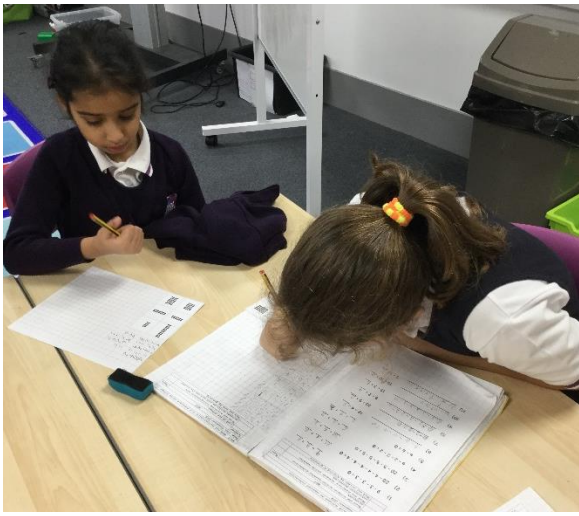
This week we have started learning about our second modern master, Salvador Dali. The children have been really engaged and fascinated by his work. Earlier this week they chose one of his paintings to write a description, and the children used exciting adjectives. In English we looked at the different parts of speech and used them in our writing. The children have shown good understanding of personal pronouns and worked hard to use adverbs and adjectives in their sentences.



In Spanish this week the children were learning the words for colours and it is great to see the children really enjoying this through songs and actions.



In Maths we continued used our previously acquired multiplication and division skills to solve problems and understand the connection between the two types of calculations.



In PE this week we were continuing to explore movements and actions with a ball. The children showed great coordination and good control of the ball when bouncing the ball in the hoop whilst moving around the outside of it.
