Elgar Class: Week 4

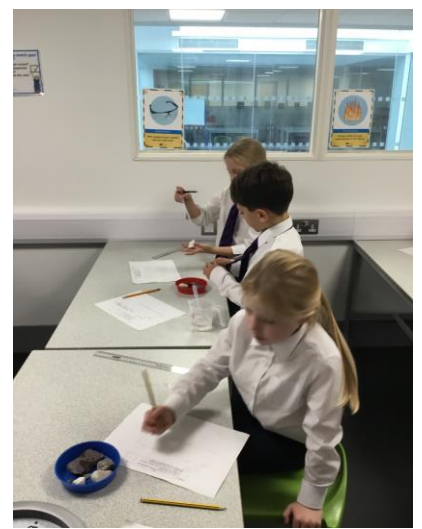
Another busy week has come to an end – time is flying by; not long until the first half term break. This week we started to talk about Black History Month and how different people were working for and still are to make the world a place where there is no prejudice.

In English we have started our text unit on “A pebble in my pocket” and the children have shown great engagement and interest during the lessons. We started with writing expanded noun phrases about a pebble I brought in. They had to think of adjectives and memories. The next lesson we introduced the term “golden lines” using the first 2 pages of the book and children drew a volcano erupting with different “golden lines”. On Thursday children were working in small groups to put together a short drama script based on some pages we read from the book. The outcome was wonderfully varied – some great ideas and collaboration by all.

Our maths lessons were all about adding and subtracting. The children have shown some great skills when calculating different sums and working out reasoning and problem solving skills. They are gaining greater awareness of how place value is linked to calculation and how it can help them to work out the answers more easily.

In Topic we have been learning about Mary Anning and her discovery of the Ichteosaur skeleton in Lyme Regis. The children worked in pairs to draw their interpretations of the ichteosaur and wrote facts about Mary Anning around it. A lovely range of drawings and facts.

Our Science lesson was about finding out which rocks are waterproof, absorbent or permeable. The children used different resources when conducting the fair test. Some children decided their own fair test and the corresponding table to write down the results.



STAR WORK:

This week Alfie and Cameron received the certificates. Alfie for working hard with our Science experiment and Cameron for his addition and subtraction work in maths.

WEEK 5:

ENGLISH – We will continue with our text unit and work on the use of prefixes and suffixes.

MATHS – We will continue to focus on Addition and Subtraction.

TOPIC – We will be learning about the different theories on how dinosaurs became extinct.

SCIENCE – We will be learning about how rocks change over time.

Reminders:

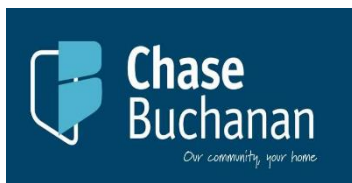
