This week, the children have been busy at Twickenham Primary Academy in lessons as usual, and I have had the opportunity to observe lots of learning to capture how our children are progressing so far this academic year. I was so pleased to see how hard our children in year one have been working on understanding how to partition 10s and 1s, how are reception pupils are progressing in phonics as they begin to develop their early reading skills and I have also seen the fantastic Science achievements that our year twos and threes have made so far.

I also know how much our year two children enjoyed their scooter training this week which I'm sure will support our children in staying safe as they ride their scooters to and from school particularly during the winter months.

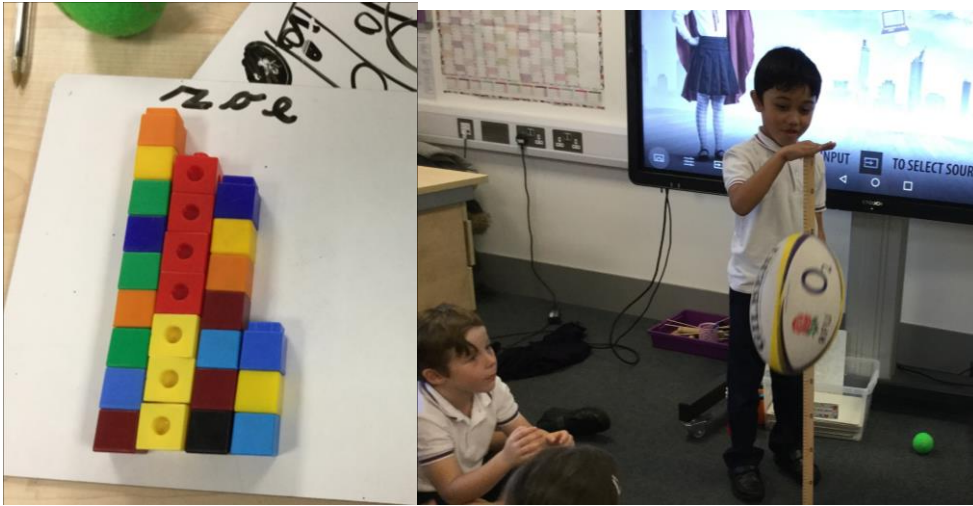
Darwin Class: Autumn 1 Week 3

Dear Parents,

In English we have been learning to use question marks correctly and the children were brilliant at reading statements and writing a question to match. We have also been building upon our knowledge of conjunctions and completing sentences using the conjunctions 'and, but, because and so'.

In Maths we have been partitioning two and three digit numbers mentally as well as using objects to support. We have then built upon this and the children impressed me with their ability to answer word problems using their partitioning skills.

In Science this week we have completed an experiment to find out which ball is the bounciest ball and why. We tested a rugby ball, table tennis ball, tennis ball and football and found out that the tennis ball was the bounciest at 90cm high! We then discussed why a ball needs bounce well in tennis and not so much in football. The children created bar charts using cubes to demonstrate their results.



In Art we have started to create our Tudor time houses using the shoe boxes you kindly donated to us! We began by covering the shoe boxes with paper. Next week we will be painting our houses white and creating a roof.



The children were extremely excited for their scooter training today and all thoroughly enjoyed their session. They have all learned new safety tips as well as brushing up on their scooter skills!



WEEK 5:

ENGLISH and PHONICS – We will be starting our text based learning linking to our topic. We will be looking at character descriptions and story settings.

Art- We will continue to create our Tudor houses
