

Update on Proposed Changes to the School Day

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to provide a further update regarding the proposed changes to the school day at Twickenham Primary Academy.

As previously communicated, Omnia Learning Trust submitted an application to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (LBRUT) to amend the planning condition relating to staggered start and finish times at the school.

Whilst the application remains under consideration, the process has taken significantly longer than originally anticipated. To provide certainty for families, staff and childcare providers, we have taken the decision to postpone any proposed changes to the school day until **January 2027**.

This means that the current school day arrangements will remain unchanged throughout the Autumn Term 2026.

Now that we have a confirmed timeline:

- **JAG (Junior Adventures Group)** will open bookings from next week based on the current school day arrangements.
- **School-run clubs and activities** will also open for booking in the usual way.
- We will provide further information in **September 2026** regarding the planned transition and any arrangements for January 2027.

We appreciate that this process has taken longer than expected and apologise for any uncertainty this may have caused. Thank you for your patience, understanding and continued support.

We will continue to keep families informed as soon as there are any further updates.
